Resolution for Campus-wide Poll in Regards to the Change of Alfond Sports Center Hours

Whereas: Concerns have been brought to the Student Government Association of Rollins College (SGA) from the general student body regarding the hours of the Alfond Sports Center being insufficient and in need of extension.

Whereas: The Alfond Sports Center operating hours are insufficient to meet the needs of a population with diverse academic and personal schedules. The Center is also unable to adequately accommodate a large number of individuals during peak gym times, thus warranting an extension of gym hours.

Whereas: This body has been given a mandate, by virtue of an election, to represent further and defend the concerns and rights of the students of Rollins College. As such, these concerns should be, to the best of SGA's abilities, resolved.

Whereas: The first step to finding a possible solution to this dilemma is to concretely evaluate student opinion on this issue via an electronic poll administered by the SGA.

Be it Hereby Resolved, The Student Government Association of Rollins College will:

- (1) Create a poll to gauge the student opinion on the extension of Alfond Sports Center hours.
- (2) Will empower the Public Relations Chair, or other Executive Officer as appointed by the President, to administer aforementioned poll to the student population.
- (3) Will empower the Public Relations Chair, or other Executive Officer as appointed by the President, to schedule a tabling event with computers where the poll may be administered within no less than two week's time after the passage of this legislation.
- (4) The poll is to be completed in no less than three weeks' time after the passage of this legislation or upon completion of greater than 200 entries.
