Bill for Recognition of Graduating SGA members

Whereas: The Student Government Association of Rollins College (SGA) provides little to no recognition for the service of its members: The Senate, and the Executive.

Whereas: Senators and Executive members give of their time during their terms of service, and if they serve out their term in its entirety, they should be rewarded for their commitment.

Whereas: SGA should distinguish its members at commencement with the recognition of having served in SGA during their time at Rollins. The conferring of an SGA honor cord would be an excellent way of solving this dilemma.

Be it Hereby Resolved, The Student Government Association of Rollins College will:

(1) SGA shall establish a process for applying for and receiving an honor cord to be worn at graduation.

(2) SGA will allocate the funds necessary for the purchase of the appropriate number of cords for the year.

(3) The application process for honor cords shall be handled by the Executive officer of the President's choosing, with the Internal Affairs or Chief Justice being strongly recommended.
