The regular weekly meeting of the Rollins College Student Government was held on Wednesday, January 30, 2013 at 6:30 pm, at Rollins College in the Galloway Room, the Chairman and Clerk being present. Roll was taken. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved as correct.

During Old Business, Bill 1213.10 was revisited. The Senate voted to keep the motion tabled.

During Open Forum, a Senator mentioned that for the past couple of years organizations have been breaking rules at the LipSync! performance, so maybe SGA should enact some sort of penalty this year. The Events Chair responded that there is a penalty, the organization will be automatically disqualified and will have to leave the event. The President stated that there is better information available to organizations this year, and that the last rehearsal will be the final time to make changes. If an organization makes any changes after that date they will automatically be disqualified. The Senator stated that a harsher penalty might be something to consider in the future. He also suggested that if/when Diane from Community Standards comes to SGA, SGA should work with PR to publicize the meeting really well and maybe change the venue. The President responded that we probably won't have much of a turnout, based on meetings we had last semester that were publicized, but will make every effort to publicize it to the student body. Another Senator asked if we had a date for Diane's meeting. The Student Life Chair responded no, not yet. The Events Chair mentioned that Next Wednesday Senate will be meeting in Bieberbach. The President Pro Tempore said that she received feedback about wireless printing and passed it on to Susan in the library, who said that they will be able to add wireless printing to the lab in CSS and will hopefully put a link to the website on the Olin webpage.

The meeting adjourned at 6:52 pm.
