During Old Business, the Senate voted to keep Bill 1213.10 tabled.

During New Business, the Senate voted to adopt Bill 1213.13. The President stated that next week SGA will be holding elections for Parliamentarian. The Senate voted to adopt the motion to create Course Evaluation Revision Committee.

During Open Forum, the Internal Relations Chair explained that Course Evaluation Revision committee would be proposing suggestions for new questions for course evaluations because PSC requested student input on the issue. A Senator mentioned that next week he would be proposing legislation for fair trade at Rollins. The Chief Justice reminded the Senators that, as per their contracts, they must complete one piece of legislation and two constituent outreaches this semester. A Senator mentioned that the Rollins Cares Student Committee is doing a time capsule and that SGA can donate something as a group. Another Senator mentioned that Pinehurst is having a yoga/eating disorder program. The Student life Chair asked the Senators how many of them would actually be interested in using the gym if it were open till midnight. A Senator suggested that SGA consider sending out a survey Another Senator suggested that the survey could include other questions as well. Another Senator said that maybe there could be a trial
