Resolution for Student Ambassador Program for Holt

Whereas: Holt students are not permitted to participate as a Rollins Ambassador for the Admissions Department,

Whereas: There is currently no student representation in regards to the Holt Admissions process,

Whereas: Students deserve a chance to represent the college no matter what school they belong to,

Be it Hereby Resolved, The Student Government Association of Rollins College will:

- (1) Support the development of a Rollins Ambassador program for the Hamilton Holt School.
- (2) Have the Holt School Senators take the lead in helping to organize and create the program so that it can become effective before the end of Spring 2015.
- (3) Pass this measure by "roll call vote" to increase senator ownership of their votes and stress to them the importance of their votes
