Whereas: Students have expressed the lack of representation and consideration within the current disciplinary system, leading to students to be found guilty of allegations presented against them.

Whereas: This may lead to the delegation of sanctions that are inappropriate for the actions or allegations that the student may or may not have committed, leading to an unrepresentative and unjust disciplinary system.

Whereas: The current judicial system is currently structured in a way that is disconnected from student interests and opinions. We propose to bring in a representative from the Office of Community Standards so that student concerns can be heard and to discuss ways in which these shortcomings may be resolved.

Be it Hereby Resolved, The Student Government Association of Rollins College will:

- (1) Request the presence of staff members from the Office of Community Standards to speak and take questions at a Senate meeting.
- (2) Invite members of the student body to Senate to voice questions and concerns towards the office.
- (3) Create a standing committee to meet with the Office of Community Standards bi-monthly to discuss progress within said office and to develop a better relationship between Community Standards and the student body.
