Constitutional Amendment: Standing Committees

SPONSOR: Matthew Cassidy and Davin Laskin

DATE: September 9, 2015

Whereas: The campus safety committee should be a standing committee.

Be it Hereby Resolved, The Student Government Association of Rollins College will:

(1) Make the following changes to the Constitution:

- 1) Change Article VII, Section 3, Subsection C; Campus Safety Committee
- 2) Change Article VII, Section 3, Subsection C; Membership: Chair will be appointed by SGA President and Pro-tempore at the beginning of the Fall Term. Any Student interested in Campus Safety may join the committee.

a. Duties:

- I. To represent student opinion in the ticket appeals process
- II. To solicit feedback on Campus Safety.
- III. To engage in conversations with the Department of Campus Safety on how to improve services and student well-being.
- IV. To build community with and around the Campus Security Department stated in the Rollins College Student Government Association.

b. Chairman:

- I. The Chairman of the Committee will also serve as ticket appeals chair.
