Constitutional Amendment: Attorney General Expansion

SPONSOR: Matthew Cassidy and Natesh Kirpalani

DATE: September 30, 2015

Whereas: The attorney general's role should be expanded upon to serve the college in a greater capacity.

Be it Hereby Resolved, The Student Government Association of Rollins College will:

Make the following changes to the Constitution:

- I. Add to Article VII, Section 1, Subsection B, X; The Attorney General must work on a special project that aims to provide a service to all students of Rollins College. This project is to the discretion of the Attorney General but must be confirmed by a 60% majority vote by the senate.
