Meeting Minutes 3/26/2021

In attendance: Giselda Beaudin, Ed Bustos, Hilary Cooperman, Jim Johnson, Emily Nodine, Alberto Prieto-Calixto, Blake Robinson, Marc Sardy

- Approval of February meeting minutes Ed motions to approve, Jim seconds: approved
- Announce Doragnes Bradshaw's new role – Regional Director of Development
- Proposal for CLA Semester Program Portfolio Revisions
  - Has been approved by CLA/Holt study abroad sub-committee
  - Seeking approval from full committee before beginning next steps to institute the proposed changes
  - IP will work with relevant faculty and departments before finalizing the program closures list. They would then go forward in a batch to the CLA Curriculum committee for review.
  - New programs would go through a full, individual proposal process and approval process through the CLA curriculum committee.
  - Marc Sardy share feedback from business department
    - Business faculty were comfortable with changes
    - INB faculty favored keeping QMUL, rather than Lancaster since QMUL is part of the University of London system
    - INB faculty favored keeping the University of Sydney
  - After discussion, Marc Sardy made a motion to approve proposal but with changes to retain Queen Mary University and University of Sydney as approved programs
    - 2 approve, 6 no, 2 abstain: motion does not pass
  - Giselda made a motion to approve the proposal as written
    - 5 in favor, 3 no's, 2 abstain: motion passes
  - Next steps will be for Giselda to gather feedback from other departments and faculty that would be impacted by proposed closures.
  - Giselda will take the recommendations from INB into account as she continues to move this forward.
  - Since it is still being developed, it will not move forward to Curriculum Committee until fall 2021.
- RIG Grants
  - Changes to wording for eligibility and criteria
  - Agreed to vote by email on this
- Plan for increasing student engagement with global learning: Tabled until next meeting
