Constitutional Amendment: Organization Eligibility

DATE: April 22nd, 2015

Whereas: The Student Government Association works to create an inclusive campus for the student body. It respects the needs and interests for organizations seeking representation within the Senate.

Be it Hereby Resolved, The Student Government Association of Rollins College will:

Make the following changes to the Constitution:

(1) Add Article VII, Section 2, Subsection C:

IV: At-Large Senators:

- i. Each organization or program shall set its own eligibility criteria of selection, but shall follow, at least, the following standards:
 1. Representatives must have run for a seat in the Senate in a timely manner in the given year as specified in the Election Rules.
 2. No criteria can be in conflict with any university policy.
- ii. The Senator shall be responsible for communication between the Organization and the Senate.
- iii. The Senator shall also fulfill all other duties of elected class senators, except for Article VII, Section 2, Subsection C, part ii. *Represents and communicates with the students from the class years which they are elected.*
