Constitutional Amendment: President Pro-tempore

Whereas: The legislative branch should decide the chairs of its committees

Be it Hereby Resolved, The Student Government Association of Rollins College will:

Make the following changes to the Constitution:

- 1) Add to Article VII, Section 2, Subsection C; The President Pro-tempore will decide the chairs of each SGA Standing and Ad-hoc committee.
- 2) Shall appoint a Sergeant-at-Arms from among the Student Body. This individual will, at the discretion of the Chair, request any individual to remove him or herself from the Senate Chambers and assist the Chief Justice in enforcing attendance policy and help to ensure quorum. The Sergeant-at-Arms must abide by the Senator Attendance policy.
