#### **Updates with Dean Crown**

- Update on Covid:
  - o reminder to be vigilant and make sure all students are being reminded of all the criteria around social distancing and the TARS promise
  - Vaccinations: not available at this point
  - Mode of Participation: We follow up with students that change their form of participation without notifying us in advance. Our policy allow students to change their mode of participation by contacting <u>crummerregistrar@rollins.edu</u> by noon on Thursday.
- Budget
  - we have been able to outperform the enrollment numbers incorporated into the budget
  - the restoration announced by President Cornwell applies to base salaries, not other forms of compensation
  - o the budget for next year will mirror this year
- Enrollment: pacing ahead of last year; we are significantly ahead of other institutions
  - Tuition reimbursement for Crummer remains paused for now
- Political Environment we are partnering with Rollins to address concerns of students (and faculty) for any issues that may surface during the transition
- AACSB
  - We are in our AACSB year
  - visit will take place in spring 2022; faculty members may be asked to be on a subcommittee.
- Registration: the PMBA60 & 61 are registering for summer electives next week
- Commencement Update: we are not sure whether the ceremony will in-person or virtual; this is a Rollins-wide decision
