 - All deliverables for a course are due during a week in which a class meets (not during project period); the exception is for travel-based courses where assignments may be due up to two weeks after the end of the travel period; any allowance for late assignments due to travel must be offered to ALL students in the class; final deliverables due no later than the end of the last class period
