- Legislation 1819.10: Changes to Honor Code
  - Sponsor: Nam Nguyen
  - Issue addressed: Honor Code needed changes, such as Holt being allowed on the Honor Council and details about use of cellular devices.
  - Result: Approved, legislation passes
- Legislation 1819.11: Wakeboarding Club Boat Use
  - Sponsor: Joey Huttman

- Issue addressed: Wakeboard club does not currently have access to a boat, which is required for their sport. Rollins should provide the necessary equipment for the Wakeboarding team, as well as a faculty advisor, so they are able to take the boat on the lake.
  - Result: Approved, legislation passes
- Legislation 1819.12: Latex-Free Condoms in Wellness Center
  - Sponsor: Sydney Brown
  - Issue addressed: The Wellness Center does not offer latex-free condoms, while latex allergies are very common. Moving forward, SGA will recommend that the Wellness Center provides students with free latex condoms to promote responsible and safe sexual behaviors among and between students
  - Result: Approved, legislation passes
- Legislation 1819.13: Faculty and Staff Appreciation Day Committee
  - Sponsor: Kyla Snow, Durston Gagliano, Jack Gabriel
  - Issue addressed: Rollins College presently has no specifically designated time for the appreciation of faculty and staff employed by Rollins College. Moving forward, SGA should establish an ad-hoc committee dedicated to establishing and the event planning of a Faculty and Staff Appreciation Day/Week.
  - Result: Approved, legislation passes
- Legislation 1819.15: Food Pantry
  - Sponsor: Jocelyn Fritzsche, Hali Reedy
  - Issue addressed: Rollins College should support efforts that promote equality and provide aid to students on campus. The Student Support Foundation (SSF) maintains an open food pantry that is accessible to students who demonstrate financial need. Moving forward, SGA should allocate funds of \$250 per each month within a semester for food items for the SSF food pantry, with a \$1000 cap.
  - Result: Approved, legislation passes
- Legislation 1819.16: Health and Wellness
  - Sponsor: Kalli Joslin, Pilar Macias, and Bridget Gorman
  - Issue addressed: PED 101: Health and Wellness is a required course at Rollins and Rollins is comprised of a diverse community whose health and wellness needs vary, especially regarding gender and sexuality. However, this course does not currently educate about subject. Moving forward, SGA will endorse better and more inclusive curriculum regarding gender and sexuality in Health and Wellness courses, beginning in Spring 2019. Also, SGA will recommend to require each Health and Wellness class to include at least one guest speaker/community partner discussing LGBT+ health and wellness
  - Result: Tabled.
- Legislation 1819.16: SGA Support for Sandspur
  - Sponsor: Jessica Gonzalez
  - Issue addressed: Rollins College SGA will participate in an event with the Rollins College student-run newspaper, The Sandspur, to help foster increased circulation of the school paper. Rollins College SGA should help foster better communication and transparency by uploading Senate meeting minutes to the Rollins College SGA website in a timely manner.
  - Result: Approved, legislation passes
