Rollins College Student Government Association 2018-2019 Dress Code

Legislation: 1819.02

Whereas: Revising the dress code of the Rollins College Student Government Association to promote and facilitate an environment where every senator's membership is respected equally.

Whereas: The Rollins College Student Government Association aspires to create an atmosphere of solidarity and kinship within the organization in order to work efficiently as a body.

Be it Hereby Resolved, The Student Government Association of Rollins College will:

- 1) Revise the dress code from a set of specific guidelines that defined the term business casual to be changed instead to the following by adding Part I the stated below in Article VI, Section 2, Subsection C:
 - a. All members of Student Government Association will adhere to the following dress code of business casual along with:
 1. the SGA sponsored polo shirt
 - a. Each member of SGA will be given a polo shirt with every member's position embroidered on the torso.
 2. A nametag that states every member's first and last name.
 3. Close-toed shoes – with exceptions made possible for business casual appropriate footwear
 - ii. All ordinance of the dress code will be enforced by the Chief Justice.
