Allergy Protocol Review

Whereas: Rollins College catering and dining services should support all students with food allergies by providing them with the utmost care and security. Through extensive training and proper allergen labels on every food product necessary, the Rollins College community will be able to reliably and effectively serve all students and faculty.

Be it Hereby Resolved, The Student Government Association of Rollins College will:

- (1) Require *all* food allergies to be labeled on food products containing allergens and possible allergens.
- (2) Require an allergy protocol overview for all new personnel hired.
- (3) Implement monthly advising during normal meetings to clarify the allergy protocol to all employees.
