Legislation Title: Straws On Campus

Whereas: Students should be cognizant of their impact on the environment.

Whereas: While the use of paper, pasta, and other alternatives to plastic straws can be very beneficial to our wildlife, these straws can be hazardous to people with disabilities.

Whereas: Alternatives to plastic straws pose choking and other health risks to individuals with motor impairments.

Be it resolved the Rollins College Student Government will:

1. Will require that all on-campus dining locations have a supply of plastic straws available upon the request of the customer and continue to promote the use of alternatives to plastic straws for individuals who do not need them.
2. Remind Sodexo employees that the presence of a cane, walker, wheelchair, crutches, or a service animal are not grounds for deciding whether or not a student needs a plastic straw.
