Whereas: Everyone at Rollins deserves the right to use a bathroom in which they feel safe;

Whereas: Rollins is comprised of a diverse community whose members do not all fit into binary definitions of cisgender “men” and “women”;

Whereas: Gender-neutral bathrooms are more convenient for everyone, as they provide more options and reduce long wait times;

Whereas: Rollins has already successfully converted the multi-stall restrooms in the TJ’s Tutoring Center of Olin Library to be gender-neutral;

Whereas: The following buildings currently have no gender-neutral bathrooms: Bush Science Center, Alfond Sports Center, Carnegie Hall, Orlando Hall, Keene Hall, Bush Executive Hall/Crummer Hall, Annie Russell Theatre, 170 W. Fairbanks, and 203 E. Lyman;

Be it Hereby Resolved, The Student Government Association of Rollins College will:

- (1) Send representatives to meet with Vice President of Student Affairs Dr. Mamta Accapadi and Provost Dr. Susan Singer about converting at least two restrooms in the aforementioned buildings to be gender-neutral.
- (2) Recommend to the Facilities Department of Rollins to convert at least two restrooms in the aforementioned buildings to be gender-neutral over the 2019 summer break, additionally installing a deadbolt if necessary for privacy.
