**Open Study Spaces**

**Whereas:** The study spaces in Olin library are usually full and offer few private study rooms, especially during midterms and finals week.

**Whereas:** Students prefer private study spaces over public study areas.

**Whereas:** Bush offers multiple student study rooms and private classrooms for students to study without distractions.

**Whereas:** The main doors to Bush are locked to the general public during off-hours, limiting access to only faculty and students.

**Whereas:** Available study spaces should be utilized by students.

**Whereas:** Students have 24/7 access to Bush, yet they do not have 24/7 access to individual classrooms and private study spaces.

**Be it Hereby Resolved, The Student Government Association of Rollins College will:**

- (1) Endorse the policy to leave available rooms unlocked and open for student use.
- (2) Have Brock speak with Ken Miller in order to find out why the classroom doors are being locked.
