COVID-19 Anti-Harassment Act

Whereas: Rollins College should prevent all forms of harassment or abuse, as defined in the Rollins College Code of Community Standards under the Abuse (Physical, Mental, or Verbal) section, as well as the Computer and Other Electronic Misuse heading.

Whereas: All instances of harassment and misconduct of students, faculty, staff, and campus guests not adhering to COVID-19 policies should be reported to administration.

Be it Hereby Resolved, The Student Government Association of Rollins College will:

- (1) Promote positive student adherence to COVID-19 guidelines, through student spotlights on social media;

- (2) Distribute the anonymous report form link (https://cm.maxient.com/reportingform.php?RollinsCollege&layout_id=13) via social media to remind students of a way to report incidents;
- (3) Communicate with the Rollins College social media team, so that they can distribute the anonymous report form link;
- (4) Communicate with Campus Safety and Rollins administration to establish enforcement policies for Rollins students, faculty, staff, as well as guests;
- (5) Work with administration to establish an educational conference or hearing for students who continuously disregard both COVID-19 and Abuse policies;
- (6) Work with administration to ensure that current COVID-19 and harassment policies are being enforced and disseminated;
- (7) Encourage students who are aware of any physical, verbal, or cyber harassment or abuse concerning COVID-19 policy to immediately report it to the College through the anonymous reporting system or with Campus Safety;
- (8) Request that all SGA senators implement these same guidelines as representatives of the Rollins community.

According to legislation 1920.07, the Chief Justice must ask for a legislation update two weeks after a legislation passes.

Here is our update:

We reached out to the SGA Public Relations chair about sharing the anonymous report form link on the SGA Instagram. We also reached out to other student organizations about sharing a COVID-19 anti-harassment post on their social media channels.

In addition, we met with Dean Hayner to discuss social media harassment, as well as COVID-19 policies. We suggested sending out weekly or bi-weekly text messages to update students, faculty, and staff on positive COVID-cases, remind them to check the dashboard, and continue to encourage everyone to follow policies put in place to keep everyone safe. Dean Hayner told us he would carry that idea forward to the rest of the Student Affairs team.
