**Whereas: The common spaces in many residential halls on campus are lacking a welcoming, congenial feel with many bare walls**

**Whereas: An opportunity should be offered to students to create an inclusive, community-based environment in their residential halls**

**Whereas: Community generated artwork will build community in a time of separation on campus**

**Be it Hereby Resolved, the Student Government Association of Rollins College will:**

1. Sponsor an art competition alongside Residential Life & Explorations
  - a. Artwork will be submitted to an Instagram account (@rollins.artcompetition) and promoted on the Rollins SGA Instagram and Residential Life & Explorations Instagram
  - b. SGA Senators & Executive Board will support the competition by liking and/or sharing their favorite submissions and by spreading the word
  - c. Entries can be submitted from December 6, 2020 – January 3, 2021, the top 11 entries will have their artwork printed and a piece will be hung in Cross, Pinehurst, Elizabeth, Holt, Rex Beach, Strong 219, Strong 220, Strong 221, Sutton, Lakeside, and Ward

2. Allocate a \$1,200 budget for 11 16x24 metal prints at \$74.80/print, 11 float mounts at \$24.00/mount from HH Color Labs, \$10 for flyers for advertising, and 11 certificates at \$0.95/certificate for the 11 entries with the most likes by January 24, 2021
