Whereas: The Student Government Association does not currently have an organizational senator tasked with representing the Information Technology department.

Whereas: The Information Technology department has become increasingly prevalent to campus policy and the Rollins experience, specifically with regards to Instructor/Student interactions. Students & Faculty rely on IT infrastructure both in the classroom & across campus to enhance learning, access canvas, resolve technical issues, etc.

Whereas: Organizational Senators are designed to represent the various departments relevant to campus involvement and policy.

Whereas: Article 4, Section 2, Subsection C.I.2.b states:

b. "Organizational Senator Positions: Ten senators represent different focus areas and offices/departments around campus (one senator per organization)", but 15 organizational senator positions are listed.

Whereas: The sponsors have identified a candidate prepared to fill the position of Information Technology senator upon passage of this legislation.

Be it hereby resolved by the Student Government Association of Rollins College will:

- (1) Amend Article 4, Section 2, Subsection A to strike the word "ten" from the fourth line and replace it with the word "sixteen".
- (2) Amend Article 4, Section 2, Subsection B.1 to strike the word "ten" from the third line and replace it with the word "sixteen"
- (3) Amend Article 4, Section 2, Subsection C.I.2.b to strike the word "ten" from the first line and replace it with the word "sixteen".
 - (a) Add "Information Technologies Senator report to the Office of Information Technology and assist SGA with any technology-related issues during meetings"
- (4) Amend section VII of the SGA agenda to include Information Technology senator reports for all future senate meetings.
