Printing Accessibility Act

Whereas: Student access to printers on campus is limited to Bush Science Center, Kathleen W Rollins Hall, and Olin Library.

Whereas: Students perform academic work at all times of the day, especially after business hours, jobs, or extracurriculars, and an important part of student work involves printing, including but not limited to, essays, assignments, posters, etc. The only building available on campus 24 hours a day is Bush Science Center

Whereas: No residence hall on campus provides printing access to students, requiring them to potentially leave their secure residence halls at night to print at another building on campus, including Sutton Apartments, located next to a public park. This poses a threat to the safety of students walking alone at night.

Be it hereby resolved, the Student Government Association of Rollins College will:

- (1) Work with the Residence Life & Exploration office to establish a plan and budget to install student-access printers in accessible places in Lakeside Neighborhood and Sutton Apartments.
- (2) Draft a plan to have these printers restocked on a regular basis and maintenance as required.
- (3) After finalizing the plan and relevant details outlined in (1) and (2), install accessible printers, like those found in Bush Science Center, Kathleen W Rollins Hall, etc., in Sutton Apartments and Lakeside Neighborhood
