ALUMNI FUND

Listed on the following pages are the names of Rollins Alumni who contributed to the 1956-57 Alumni Fund. Final figures on the books, which closed June 30 for the fund year, show that 845 Alumni gave a total of \$16,107.86 to Rollins College during the 1956-57 campaign which began last October.

Of the total amount contributed \$8,744.70 came directly to the Alumni Fund for unrestricted use by the College. \$7,363.16 came from Alumni to the College for specific purposes — Diamond Jubilee, Library, scholarships and general fund.

Breaking the contributions down into statistics shows that 19 percent of the Alumni, who were solicited, contributed to the fund and the average gift was \$19.00. These figures also show that approximately 100 more Alumni contributed this second year of the Annual Alumni Fund plan than for the first year, with an increase of nearly \$1,000 in amount coming directly to the Alumni Fund.

The response this year indicates that Rollins Alumni are exceptional. It is usual for the response to fall off somewhat for the second year of an Alumni Fund program. We not only held our own but showed an increase all along the line.

Note: Every effort has been made to include the name of each and every contributor to the Alumni Fund. It is possible, in a list as large as this one, to miss someone. Should this occur, please let us know at once and please be assured that it was not intentional.

FORD GRANT

Rollins has received final payment of \$239,000 on the \$459,000 Ford Foundation grant which was awarded to the College in December 1955. This is \$90,000 more than the original grant which was \$369,000. Rollins was the only college in Florida to receive an accomplishment grant for its work in raising faculty salaries. The total amount has been added to the College endowment fund and income from it will be used to increase faculty salaries.

SOCCER SCHEDULE

DEAN OF MEN

Dr. Dyckman W. Vermilye, who has been associate director of housing at the University of Florida since 1955, has been appointed dean of men at Rollins College. He succeeds Joe Justice who was named director of athletics last, spring, and who will devote his full time to his new duties.

Dr. Vermilye, with his wife, two sons and two daughters have already come to Winter Park to make their home.

He received his B.A. in political science at the College of William and Mary, Williamsburg, Va.; his M.A. in educational psychology, University of Minnesota, Minneapolis and his Ed.D., in student personnel administration at Teachers College, Columbia University.

A Phi Delta Kappa and Kappa Delta Pi, Dr. Vermilye is a member of the American Personnel and Guidance Association; American College Personnel Association and is on the executive council, Southern College Personnel Association.

MENS DORM

Construction work on Rex Beach Hall, the new dormitory for men, is being pushed and as the RECORD goes to press the masonry walls have been completed and roofing joists installed on the \$198,000 addition to the Campus. Completion of the new building, which will house 51 men, is expected before the fall term begins.

The cornerstone was officially laid on Commencement Day. A copy of "The Spoilers" by the famous Alumnus and Author, for which the new building is named, and a copy of the citation he received when he was awarded an honorary Doctor of Literature degree from his Alma Mater, were included in the box which was sealed inside.

116 NEW ALUMNI

Members of the class of 1957, 116 of them, became Rollins Alumni, when they were handed their diplomas by President Hugh McKean, in Knowles Memorial Chapel, Friday morning, June 7.

The commencement address was delivered by U.S. Senator Clifford P. Chase of New Jersey, a graduate of Rutgers University, and holder of honorary degrees from Columbia University and Middlebury College. He was awarded an honorary Doctor of Laws degree following the awarding of the diplomas to the members of the class of 1957.

Oliver K. Eaton, of Winter Park, long time friend of Rollins, was awarded the honorary degree of Doctor of Humane Letters.

Receiving the Algernon Sydney Sullivan Medallion were graduating seniors: Kenneth Pahel of State College, Penn., and Marion Polson of Ithaca, N.Y.

The Rollins Decoration of Honor was awarded to Mrs. Alice McBride Hansen, librarian at Mills Memorial Library and Joseph Justice, retiring dean of men and new director of athletics for Rollins.

The General Reeve award for top scholarship went to Ronald Fishbaugh, Orlando; Kathleen Klein, Winter Park; Shirley Leech, Canton, Ohio; Jack Powell, Orlando and Richard Trismen, Winter Park.

Commencement Day began with the traditional Alumni Senior breakfast at the Old Family Tree on Lake Virginia, when members of the class of 1957 were guests of the members of Rollins Alumni Inc. According to tradition the academic procession formed in front of Carnegie Hall and, headed by the Rollins Choir, marched across the campus to Knowles Memorial Chapel. The academic procession though often repeated was as always a colorful and inspiring sight.
