MINUTES OF THE FACULTY 1956-57

The seventh, a special meeting of the Rollins College Faculty was held at 4:15 p.m. on Tuesday, February 19, 1957 in the Visitors' Lounge of Carnegie Hall with the following members present: Mr. McKean, Mr. French, Mr. Allen, Mrs. Campbell, Mrs. Dean, Mr. Dewart, Mr. Dorsett, Mr. Douglass, Miss Drinkwater, Mrs. Grand, Mrs. Kemp, Mrs. Koontz, Mrs. Magoun, Mrs. Morehouse, Miss Ortmayer, Miss Packham, Miss Peterson, Mr. Rowland, Mr. Stone, Mr. Wagner, Mrs. Watson, Mr. Welsh, Mr. Wilson.

Mr. McKean opened the meeting by discussing the details of the Animated Magazine and Convocation. He announced that the first Diamond Jubilee Award, a citation and medal, would be presented at the Convocation.

He explained that models of the proposed new buildings to be erected on the Rollins campus will be shown at the Founder's Day dinner; they will then be on display in the Visitors' Lounge.
