It was moved by Mr. Weinberg, seconded by Dr. Newman, that the candidates be accepted. CARRIED.

Dean Anderson presented the name of Cloyd Harlan Russell for the degree of Master of Science. Dr. Georgia, chairman of the graduate committee, recommended that Mr. Russell be granted the degree when and if he completes the requirements to the satisfaction of the committee and that his name be placed on the list with a star. Seconded by Mr. Weinberg. CARRIED.

Dean Anderson read the list of the following students and asked the recommendation of the Faculty as to their receiving a degree cum laude. Lula Cashwell, 477 honor points; Mary Kinser, 460 honor points; Boyd Kyner, 458 honor points; Marguerite T. Libbey, 464 honor points. Mr. Weinberg moved that the four be granted the honor. Seconded by Dr. Campbell. CARRIED.

Commencement announcements were made by Dean Anderson.

Dr. Clarke offered the following recommendation from the Curriculum Committee: "The adviser and the dean shall have the power to allow one waiver with substitution in the Lower Division requirements, with the right of appeal within one term thereafter to the Board of Admissions should the student be dissatisfied." On the motion of Dr. Newman, the recommendation was CARRIED.

The meeting adjourned at 4:10 P.M.
