Minutes of the Faculty for December 10, 1931.

The third meeting of the Rollins College Faculty for the year 1931-32 was called to order by Dean Anderson at 3:55 P. M., Thursday, December 10.

The following members were present:

A report for the Committee on the Faculty Gift to the Chapel was made by the chairman, Dean Campbell, in which he suggested that the faculty gift be used for beautification in the garden between the Chapel and Little Theater, being concentrated on the construction of a fountain or some other project in accord with the general plan of beautification, and recommended that the money be made available at once to the landscape architect and beautification committee. A motion was made by Dean Campbell, seconded by Mr. Lounsbury, that the treasurer be authorized to collect the \$500 pledged by the faculty and make it available for use as soon as possible. CARRIED.

Dr. Georgia, chairman of the Curriculum Committee, on the recommendation of the committee made the following motion: That the Faculty delegate to the Curriculum Committee the duty of preparing and revising a list of approved activities to meet the requirements of physical fitness. Seconded by Mr. Weinberg.

Mr. France amended the motion by adding: After conference with the entire staff of the Physical Education Department. Seconded by Mr. Forbes.

After general discussion on the subject of requiring students to enter organized activities and the extension of the list of such activities, Dr. Georgia, with the consent of the second, offered the following substitute motion: That the statement on physical fitness be changed to read: In addition to the above academic requirements, admission to the Upper Division will be contingent on the student maintaining himself in a condition of physical fitness in relation to his work as shown by suitable periodic examinations. CARRIED.

During the discussion the time was extended 10 minutes on motion of Mr. Weinberg, seconded by Dean Bingham.

A second extension of five minutes was voted on motion of Mr. Weinberg, seconded by Mr. Sproul.

Dean Anderson made a number of announcements relative to the winter term registration and the Christmas vacation.

A letter from James H. Ottaway, editor-in-chief of the Sandspur, was read, inviting members of the Faculty to publish communications in the Sandspur and suggesting the appointment of a faculty editor. Dr. Georgia moved that the Faculty accept this invitation and indicate its desire to participate. Seconded and carried. Mr. Brown moved that Mr. Wattles be made faculty editor. Seconded and carried.

The meeting adjourned at 5:15 P.M.
