Minutes of the Faculty for June 3, 1929

The sixteenth meeting of the Rollins College Faculty was called to order by President Holt in Professor Grover's room at 3:45 p.m., Monday, June 3, 1929.

Dean Anderson recommended that they be granted degrees upon completion of the work of the third term. Professor Harris, seconded by Professor Grover, moved that these degrees be granted. Considerable discussion. Professor Jenks moved that the motion be amended, seconded by Professor Georgia, that these degrees be granted providing full requirements are met and all course work be made up before June 5. Those not meeting all requirements are to be starred and given blank diplomas. Amendment and motion PASSED.

Dean Anderson recommended that Ross Robertson, Rodman Lehman and Ruth Ward be granted degrees with cum laude. Professor Bailey moved that these be granted as per above recommendation, seconded by Professor Wattles. Professor Jenks, seconded by Professor Georgia, moved to amend to give cum laude to Ross Robertson only. PASSED.

The faculty voted 9 to 7 to give cum laude to Ruth Ward and Rodman Lehman.

Professor Nice moved to give Alvera Barbor cum laude; motion lost 9 to 7.

Since the record of Ross Robertson was so much better than the others, Professor Georgia moved, seconded by Professor Wattles, to give Ross Robertson magna cum laude. PASSED.
