September 24, 1926.

The meeting was called to order by President Holt.

Dr. Taintor asked that suggestions for magazine list be made up as soon as possible. He also requested that silence in the Library be enforced.

A committee composed of Mrs. Grey, Professor Sprague and Professor Weinberg was appointed to take charge of our radio programs and was asked to bring in a report at our next meeting as to how the faculty can best co-operate.

Members of the Faculty were requested to leave their addresses and telephone numbers with the secretary of the faculty.

A two hour discussion followed concerning the introduction of two hour periods. After many phases of the matter had been considered, Professor Harris moved that the new plan be tried for the morning periods. Seconded by Mrs. Taintor. After further discussion, Professor Georgia moved that the college go over entirely to the two hour period. Motion seconded by Professor Weinberg. Carried unanimously.

Professor Weinberg suggested that advanced credit be given students under the new plan. Miss McVea, Professor Jenks and Professor Weinberg were appointed a committee to report on the question at the next meeting.

It was agreed that the regular faculty meeting should be held hereafter on Thursday at 4 P. M.
