

Announcement:

- 'Department optimization plans' Conceptualized as an executive function for the dean's office and department chairs, whereas the CC is more of a legislative function. Following up on each departments attempts to autonomously "optimize" (the literal wording in the policy, which doesn't mean decrease or increase numbers, expect discussion over this within departments or inter-departmentally) enrollment of majors within their areas. There were previous policy approvals that should now be put into effect, this is simply just following up on this change. Implementing hard and fast policies for controlling enrollment in majors. For example chemistry is using data driven statistics to justify potential hard and fast policies they want to implement. Data, especially from an exam taken at some point, as good predictors for success in the chemistry major. Conversation with admissions over this process and how Rollins is marketed, to avoid bait and switch practices for students who came here under false illusions.

Business:

- Holt Only. Changes the healthcare management major into different branding name more accurate of real life, i.e. into Health Services and Leadership. Major re-shaping. Making it easier for students to think with interdisciplinarity and streamline the structure of overall major, minimizing redundancies among courses provided through student feedback. Much discussion given to the arguments in favor and against changing the name of the major and changing the course prefixes from HCM to HSL. Change in learning outcomes entails change in course number, only if the change in learning outcomes is substantial enough to make it a major change. Dealing with the semantics of justifying course number changes. Need to attune our radar for changes in course numbers and the ripple effect
