RESOLUTION: Provision of Cumulative Grades to Students Two Weeks Before the Withdrawal Deadline

SPONSORS: Jillian Rondeau, Katia Chadaideh, Ruqayyah Ali

DATE: October 30, 2013

Whereas: Students are often misled about their academic standing in a class due to their lack of knowledge about their cumulative grade.

Whereas: The process by which students must request midterm grades is inconvenient, and requests are frequently not honored by professors.

Whereas: Students are often unaware of their standing in a class until after the withdrawal deadline.

Whereas: Professors often do not compile a cumulative grade until final grades are administered.

Be It Hereby Resolved, The Student Government Association of Rollins College will:

- 1) Support an Academic Affairs committee decision to mandate that a cumulative progress report be given to all students by professors two weeks before the withdrawal deadline.
- 2) Allow the Academic Affairs committee to decide how this process should be structured.
- 3) Prefer that the progress report requirement be enforced by the spring 2014 academic semester.
