Constitutional Amendment for the inclusion of the Hamilton Holt School in Student Governance

SPONSOR: Ed Leffler, Richard Stull

DATE: October 19, 2013

Whereas: Concerns have arisen that suggest that the Hamilton Holt School (Hereafter known as Holt) has no representation in the body of the Student Government Association of Rollins College.

Whereas: Holt seeks to dissolve its own SGA which has no bearing on the decisions and responsibilities of the Student Government of Rollins College and, in turn seeks recognition and representation in our own assembly.

Whereas: The senate can only allow its number to expand in such a manner if proposed by a constitutional amendment to the Constitution of the Student Government of Rollins College.

Whereas: The Constitution of the Student Government Association of Rollins College should be amended to allow for the representation of Holt in the Senate. This representation would be made up of four members, the same amount granted to every class year in the Colleges of Arts and Science and Professional Studies.

Be it Hereby Resolved, The Student Government Association of Rollins College will:

- (1) Recognize the Hamilton Holt School's presence in its own elective assembly: The Senate.
- (2) Assist and facilitate the election of four senators drawn specifically from Holt.
- (3) Amend the Constitution of the Student Government Association of Rollins College in the following manner:
 - (a) By adding/subtracting the highlighted text to Bylaws Section 2: The Senate

Structure The Senate will be comprised of the following officers in the following order: Vice-President of SGA, the President Pro Tempore, the Parliamentarian, the Clerk of the Senate, and the elected members representing class years, the elected members representing the Hamilton Holt School, and voting delegates of appointed representative organizations

B: Membership

I. All senators must represent the Senate seats from the class year of they matriculated with, except the Hamilton Holt School Senators, who will be elected from Holt on an “at large” basis, regardless of graduation year.

(4) Given the severity of the change in the constitution the sponsoring senators request that this measure be passed by a “roll-call vote”.
