The next order of business was the nomination of Miranda Jung as a Freshman Senator. It was noted that there was not a quorum, so a vote could not take place on the matter. However, a motion was made to treat the situation as an alternate for the position instead of an appointment, since the person in question was the next runner-up in the election. The Chairman then noted that there was in fact a quorum because one more Senator arrived at the meeting, and one person was standing in for an absent Senator. A vote was taken and the motion on the table failed. A new motion was made to appoint Miranda Jung as Freshmen Senator. A vote was taken and the motion passed.



During Open Forum, a Senator asked if it was mandatory for Senators to attend the Institutional Priorities meetings. The President responded that it is not mandatory, but highly recommended. The Chairman noted that if any Senators had proposed legislation, it would have to wait until the meeting after next due to the Institutional Priorities meeting during Senate on October 10, 2012. A Senator asked what times Rolly Trolley would be taking place, to which the Events Chair responded: 1pm, 3:30pm, 5pm on Tuesday and 12pm, 6pm, 12 am Sunday of Thanksgiving Break. The President noted that if enough people decide to take Rolly Trolley, SGA can make back the money spent on the event. It was also noted that the contract with the bus company has to be made *before* sales can start for Rolly Trolley. Next, the Advisor noted that OSIL is sponsoring a “Student Org of the month” and that SGA should look into changing the school policy that food service is restricted during Thanksgiving break.

The meeting adjourned at 7:13 pm.
