During Open Forum, the ResLife Senator mentioned that Diwali will be held in 30 minutes in Campus Center. A Senior Senator asked if anyone wanted to meet up after the meeting to draft legislation. Another Senator asked about the punishment for violating the new smoking policy. The ResLife Senator responded that it is kind of a "3 strikes" situation, where you get a write up if you break the policy 3 times. Another Senator mentioned that a faculty member who lives in Ward Hall has a young son who has a vent outside his room, so to please those concerned about the new smoking policy that it is for the benefit of everyone living and working on campus. Another Senator mentioned that faculty has also been responsive to the new policy, since some of them also smoke around campus. The President noted that the new policy will not be effective until January 1st. Another Senator brought up a concern from a constituent that smoking areas in other places sometimes start out looking nice but are neglected, and end up being not aesthetically pleasing anymore.
