During Old Business, the Senate voted to keep Bill 1213.10 regarding safe housing tabled.

During New Business a representative of the Academic Honor Council gave a presentation about Honor Code violations and reporting them. Next, the Senate approved the appointment of two new Senators, Gianna Hernandez and Mackenzie Gill.

During Open Forum, the Public Relations Chair showed the Senate a new mock-up of the SGA t-shirts and asked for recommendations. One Senator asked if the logo was the official SGA logo? The PR Chair responded that it is, just with the fox added to it. The President noted that unfortunately, Strategic Marketing guidelines recommend that there are no modifications to the logo at all. Another Senator asked if we could have other colors. The President Pro-Tempore said she liked the color. One Senator asked if we could put the fox on the sleeve, and another suggested having the fox coming out of the pocket. The Internal Relations Chair asked the Senators' opinion about how to share the minutes on Facebook as per legislation passed last semester. One Senator suggested that students would be more apt to look at information in a status as opposed to clicking on a link. Another Senator suggested sharing highlights from the minutes as well as a link to the SGA website. Next, another Senator brought up the issue of enforcing the new smoking policy. The Student Life Chair said that in order for the new policy to work, it would have to be enforced by everyone, but this is not happening with students or faculty. She said that Campus Security has said that they are not the "smoking police" and that there will be an assessment of the policy at end of year. The President asked the Senate to please continue to think of ideas on how to make the current policy work because if this policy doesn't work there is a possibility that policies may become even stricter in the future. Another Senator mentioned that he has definitely seen less people smoking and a lot of people using the areas. The President brought up the issue of visitors and how they will be informed about the policy. The Finance Chair said that she has seen a lot of faculty smoking outside of the areas. The Student life Chair suggested that the Office of Student Success Senator could bring up the idea of introducing the new policy to first year students through Peer Mentors and RCC courses. Next, a Senator mentioned that she is having constituent outreach on Monday at 7 and they will be doing a Harlem Shake video. The President discussed having a table at Alumni Weekend and asked the Chair of the Exploring Rollins Traditions Committee to collaborate with the Public Relations Chair on the matter. He also said that he will be speaking at the Board of Trustees dinner and that if anyone has any issues to bring up, let him know. Previously, he had talked with the Chairman of the Board of Trustees about the value of a Rollins education and controlling costs for students. One Senator said she had talked to people who had heard rumors about Rollins' accreditation status. The President said that he would look into it and bring an official report back to the Senate at the next meeting. He also asked the Senators to keep thinking about ideas for Fox Day.
