Resolution: Support for Equal Opportunity on Fox Day

DATE: March 25, 2014

Whereas: Rollins College has multiple colleges and programs,

Whereas: Fox Day has been one of the few traditions we have at Rollins, and has been in place since 1956,

Whereas: In 1956 Rollins did not yet have Holt or Crummer, so all students were able to fully celebrate a day “deemed too beautiful to stay inside”,

Whereas: Fox Day is not just a day for a barbeque on the lawn, but a day for relaxing and stress relief with the benefit of no classes before the end of the semester begins,
