Constitutional Amendment: Attorney General

SPONSOR: Matthew Cassidy and Ruzgar Zere

DATE: September 2, 2015

Whereas: The Executive branch and judicial branch should have extended separation of powers.

Be it Hereby Resolved, The Student Government Association of Rollins College will:

Make the following changes to the Constitution:

- 1) Add to Article VII, Section 1, Subsection B, X; Attorney General.
- 2) Add to Article VII, Section 1, Subsection B, X; The role of the attorney general is to represent the executive branch during Judicial board hearings and serve as the prosecutor of any SGA offence. The Attorney General will be appointed by the President of SGA and confirmed by a two-thirds majority vote by the Senate.
