  - a. SHIP Report
    - i. Scholarship for High Impact Practices (Committee is Jim Norris, Matt Nichter, Destinee Lott, Alexa Gordon, Hanna Ewing, Gay Biery-Hamilton, Jen Atwell)
      1. Deadline is the first SHIP application deadline.
        - a. Will be sent link to Qualtrics survey after deadline (for blind application process).
