Constitutional Amendment: Judicial Board

SPONSOR: Matthew Cassidy

DATE: September 30, 2015

Whereas: The Judicial Board should be comprised of an odd number of members so that no ties take place.

Whereas: The Holt School should have more proportional representation on the Judicial Board.

Be it Hereby Resolved, The Student Government Association of Rollins College will:

(1) Make the following changes to the Constitution

1. Change Article VII, Section 3. A.;

(a) I. The Judicial board will be made up of five members:

1. An appointed Chair of the board, who will hold the position of Chief Justice of SGA
2. Three Non-senator and non-Executive Board Members that are A&S or CPS Undergraduate students appointed by the Chief Justice and President, and then Confirmed by the Senate by a two-thirds majority vote.
3. One Holt Student appointed by the Chief Justice and President, and then Confirmed by the Senate by a two-thirds majority vote.
