Resolution: Support for Equal Opportunity on Fox Day

DATE: October 7, 2015

Whereas: Rollins College has multiple colleges and programs;

Whereas: Fox Day has been one of the few traditions we have at Rollins, and has been in place since 1956;

Whereas: In 1956 Rollins did not yet have Holt or Crummer, so all students were able to fully celebrate a day “deemed too beautiful to stay inside”;

Whereas: All students are created equal, they are endowed with certain unalienable rights, and among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Fox Day;
