**Legislation 1415.26**

**Constitutional Change of Senate Membership**

**SPONSOR(S): Matthew Cassidy and Reagan Campbell**

**DATE: April 1, 2015**

**Whereas:** The membership of the Judicial Board is in conflict with Article II of the SGA Constitution

**Whereas:** The membership of the Judicial Board should be seen as role models across campus.

**Whereas:** Reviewing the Executive Board and the Senate consistently and often is necessary for the efficiency and productivity of the SGA.

**Be it Hereby Resolved, The Student Government Association of Rollins College will:**

(1) Make the following changes to the Constitution

1. Change Article VII, Section 3. A.;

(a) I. The Judicial board will be made up of six members:

1. An appointed Chair of the board, who will hold the position of Chief Justice of SGA
2. Four Non-senator or Executive Board Members that are Undergraduate students appointed by the Chief Justice and President, and then Confirmed by the Senate by a two-thirds majority vote.
3. One Holt Student appointed by the Chief Justice and President, and then Confirmed by the Senate by a two-thirds majority vote.

2. Change Article VII, Section 3. B;

(a) I. All Judicial Board Members must be in good standing with the Dean of Student Affairs.

(b) II. All Judicial Board Members must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0

1. First year students without a GPA are exempt.

(c) III. If the Judicial Board Member's GPA falls below a 3.0 and/or fails to uphold their responsibilities during their term they will be referred to the Executive Board with a decision to be made by the Executive Board and approved by the Senate.
